RULES: Matches will follow the current CMP Pistol Competition Rulebook.

- All competitors must have a completed CMP Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement on file with the club. We will have these available at the match or you can find them at:

COURSE OF FIRE: Aggregate of the .22 Rimfire Pistol Match and the Centerfire Pistol Match.

Each of those two matches is a total of 90 shots, for a total of 180 shots, and consists of:

- 20 shots slow fire (B6 targets at 50 yards)
- 30 shot National Match Course (10 shots each slow, timed, and rapid)
- 20 shots timed fire (B8 turning targets at 25 yards)
- 20 shots rapid fire (B8 turning targets at 25 yards)

PISTOL REQUIREMENTS:

- 22 Rimfire Match Pistol - Any 22 Rimfire pistol with a trigger pull of at least 2 pounds.
- Center-fire Match Pistol - Any center-fire pistol, .32 caliber or larger, with a trigger pull of at least 2.5 pounds (3.5 pounds if a .45 caliber pistol).

SAFETY: All competitors must wear eye and ear protection. Please keep all pistols cased until the start of the preparation period and unloaded until the command to load has been given. Empty chamber indicator flags will be used. All safety devices of the pistol must function properly.

LOCATION: The MSA Rifle & Pistol Range is located at 4108 E. County Road 160, Midland, TX 79706. There are restrooms on site and the clubhouse is heated and cooled. Lunch is provided as part of the match and we will have bottled water available during the match. No other snacks or drinks are available at the range.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Lunch will be provided for all competitors at no additional charge. Midland Shooters is a private club, and the gate will be closed and locked. Competitors that are not members of MSA are always welcome at our matches – please contact us prior to match day to ensure access.
